


Key Signatures



- Accidentals are note pitches that are raised or lowered a half step from their normal position in the Diatonic Scale which is determined by the Key Signature.
- Accidentals apply to all the same pitch notes within a single bar or measure.
- Key Signatures show all the accidentals (flats or sharps) found in a Scale and the accidentals are shown at the beginning of a staff to the right of the Clef. (Treble or Bass Clef)
- Key Signature is the indicator of the Tonal Center of the piece of music.
